

The bracelet has two layers. Both are beaded with spiral rope.

Cut 2,5 m Fireline. Thread a needle on both sides. String seven $11^{\circ}$ seed beads and push them to the middle of your thread. Pass through the first two beads again.



Sew through all the beads again, adding one $15^{\circ} \mathrm{A}$ after the first, second, third and fourth $11^{\circ}$.

Now you are working with both needles, one for each side. String one Cabochon (C), one $15^{\circ} \mathrm{A}$ and one C . Sew with the second needle through the unused hole, string one $15^{\circ} \mathrm{A}$ and sew through the second $C$. The beading on both sides of the bracelet is identical.


String thirteen $11^{\circ}$ and pass through the C - A - C group. Repeat on the other side.

Repeat this step until the desired length is reached.
String one $15^{\circ} \mathrm{A}$, one C and thirteen $11^{\circ}$. Pass through the last C and the new added $A$ and $C$.



To finish the layer string seven $11^{\circ}$. Pass through the first two $11^{\circ}$ again. Sew through the second hole of the cabochon. Then work the thread in.

Sew with the second thread through the first three $11^{\circ}$. Add one $A$ in the next four gaps. Pass through the last two $11^{\circ}$ and the second hole of the cabochon. Work the thread in.



Add a second thread ( 2 m length ) in the beginning of the bracelet. Both sides have equal length.
Thread a needle on both sides.

String thirteen $15^{\circ}$ on both sides. On the right side all $15^{\circ}$ are in color $A$ and on the left side in color $B$. Pass through the C-A - C - A C group



Repeat this until the end. Work the threads in. Add the clasp with split rings.
